

**Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees  
Aspermont Independent School District  
November 17, 2025**

At a regular meeting of the Aspermont Independent School District Board of Trustees held on November 17, 2025, members Ray Bradley, Jennifer Hodges, Tres Myers, Bay Hecht and Superintendent Zach Morris. Also in attendance were Mike Heid, Mike Edgin, Jeff Hurt, Robert, Betty, and Isaiah Johnson.

Superintendent Zach Morris called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Superintendent Morris led the invocation followed by the pledges.

Alexis Gaspar recognized Isaiah Johnson as the Secondary student of the month for his hard work, stepping up to be a leader, and leading by example.

Charla Brown was presented the Elementary teacher of the month award.  
Coach Colton Martin was presented the Secondary teacher of the month award.  
Kylor Murguia was awarded the student of the month for Elementary.  
No one addressed the board in open session.

Mike Heid presented the update on the Bond renovations. Demolition was set for December 1, 2025.

Following, Mike Edgin delivered the financial report for the 2024-2025 school year.

The board of trustees then moved to approve the 2024-2025 AISD financial audit report. Tres Myers motioned to approve the report as presented by Mike Edgin. Bay Hecht seconded the motion. Ray Bradley, Tres Myers, Bay Hecht, and Jennifer Hodges all voted in favor.

After reviewing the consent items, Ray Bradley made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting held on October 20, 2025. Tres Myers seconded the motion. Ray Bradley, Tres Myers, Bay Hecht, and Jennifer Hodges all voted in favor.

Tres Myers made a motion to approve bills payable from November 2025. Bay Hecht seconded the motion. Trustees Ray Bradley, Tres Myers, Bay Hecht, and Jennifer Hodges all voted in favor.

The trustees then moved to approve votes for the Stonewall County Appraisal District Board of Directors evenly amongst John Dane Gholson, Anya Mullen, Renee Spikes, and Todd Spitzer. Bay Hecht motioned to approve the votes as presented. Ray Bradley seconded the motion. Trustees Ray Bradley, Tres Myers, and Bay Hecht all voted in favor with Jennifer Hodges abstaining from vote.

Jennifer Hodges made a motion to approve the summer mandate waiver for summer feeding. Bay Hecht seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously with Ray Bradley, Tres Myers, Bay Hecht, and Jennifer Hodges all voted in favor.

Tres Myers made a motion to approve the 2025-2026 West Texas Food Service Coop interlocal agreement. Ray Bradley seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Ray Bradley, Tres Myers, Bay Hecht, and Jennifer Hodges all voted in favor.

Trustees then moved to review the 2025-2026 SPED budget. Tres Myers made a motion to approve the budget as presented. Bay Hecht seconded the motion. Ray Bradley, Tres Myers, Bay Hecht, and Jennifer Hodges all voted in favor and the motion carried.

Superintendent Zach Morris then presented the policy update 126. Ray Bradley motioned to approve the update with Jennifer Hodges seconding the motion. Motion carried. Ray Bradley, Tres Myers, Bay Hecht, and Jennifer Hodges all voted in favor.

The board of trustees then reviewed the time off request from Melva Rojas. Bay Hecht made a motion to approve the request for time off on November 25th. Tres Myers seconded the motion. Ray Bradley, Tres Myers, Bay Hecht, and Jennifer Hodges all voted in favor.

Superintendent Zach Morris then presented the letter from the House of Representatives Will Metcalf regarding the new house bill 3372. After discussion and reviewing the letter, the board chose to take no action on the item.

Superintendent Morris presented the budget report and investment report. He presented the attendance at 209 up from the previous month. He delivered the budget report with most functions being around 20%, an investment report was given. He discussed upcoming plans for the Thanksgiving lunch. The trustees discussed bond renovations.

Tres Myers then made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Ray Bradley seconded the motion. Ray Bradley, Tres Myers, Bay Hecht, and Jennifer Hodges all voted in favor.

The meeting adjourned at 7:19 pm.
