

**Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees
Aspermont Independent School District
March 19, 2026**

At a regular meeting of the Aspermont Independent School District Board of Trustees held on March 19, 2026 members Lorenzo Calamaco, Brandon Criswell, Ray Bradley, Tres Myers, Shane Polk and Superintendent Zach Morris. Absent were Bay Hecht and Jennifer Hodges. Also in attendance were Tiffany Potts, Kristin Marsh, Jeff Hurt, Mike Heid, and Jenna with Gallagher Construction.

President Lorenzo Calamaco called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Superintendent Morris led the invocation followed by Lorenzo Calamaco leading the pledges.

No one addressed the board in an open forum.

First, Mike Heid and Jenna delivered the Gallagher bond presentation and updates.

After reviewing the consent items, Tres Myers made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting held on February 20, 2026. Ray Bradley seconded the motion. Tres Myers, Lorenzo Calamaco, Shane Polk, Ray Bradley, and Brandon Criswell all voted in favor.

Brandon Criswell made a motion to approve bills payable from March 2026. Tres Myers seconded the motion. Trustees Tres Myers, Lorenzo Calamaco, Shane Polk, Ray Bradley, and Brandon Criswell all voted in favor.

Brandon Criswell then made a motion to approve the 2026-2027 contract with Edgin, Parkman, Fleming, & Fleming for auditing services. Shane Polk seconded the motion. Tres Myers, Lorenzo Calamaco, Shane Polk, Ray Bradley, and Brandon Criswell all voted in favor.

Tres Myers then made a motion to approve the cancellation of the 2026 Aspermont ISD board of trustees election. Ray Bradley seconded the motion and all were in favor. Tres Myers, Lorenzo Calamaco, Shane Polk, Ray Bradley, and Brandon Criswell all voted in favor.

Tres Myers then made a motion authorizing the superintendent to finalize and execute the performance agreement initiating participation in a Rural Pathway Excellence Partnership to be coordinated by Region 14 Education Service Center under Texas Education Code 29.912 for a term of 3 years. Shane Polk seconded the motion. Motion carried as Tres Myers, Lorenzo Calamaco, Shane Polk, Ray Bradley, and Brandon Criswell all voted in favor.

Next, Trustees moved to approve the 2026-2027 EMAT certification. Brandon Criswell made a motion to approve as presented with Tres Myers seconding the motion. Tres Myers, Lorenzo Calamaco, Shane Polk, Ray Bradley, and Brandon Criswell all voted in favor.

After explanation of the new rules from TDA, Brandon Criswell made a motion to approve documentation of the cafeteria labor meal payments. Shane Polk seconded the motion and motion carried unanimously. Tres Myers, Lorenzo Calamaco, Shane Polk, Ray Bradley, and Brandon Criswell all voted in favor.

Principal Tiffany Potts updated the board of trustees on the busy spring schedule including interim testing, book fair success, track results, OAP dinner and show, and state debate.

Superintendent Morris presented the budget report and investment report. He presented the attendance at 212. He delivered the budget report with most functions being around 65% expended and 80% received, an investment report was given. He spoke with the board of trustees regarding bond additional costs and plumbing issues.

At 7:17, Brandon Criswell made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Tres Myers seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned. The next regular meeting will be held on April 20, 2026.
